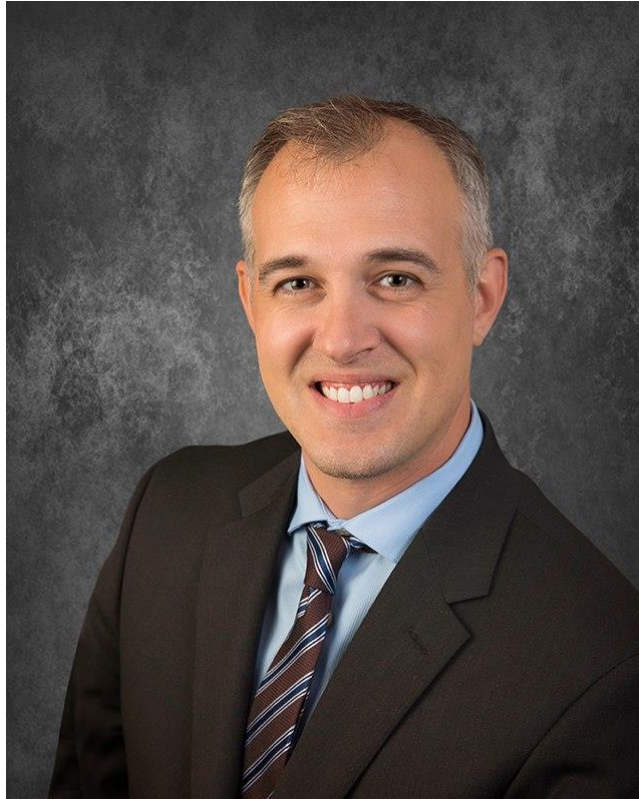


# Todd Trimpe | Candidate for Washington County Supervisor, District 4
